Employment of dedicated sports coach 1 day per week	£6000	Children experiencing high quality specialist teaching and staff are being upskilled by observing this practice. Children are enabled to compete in competitions with high quality coaching. All children to represent school on at least 1 occasion per year.	Staff are improving their skills regularly so if role ends the teaching staff would be able to maintain quality
Employment of specialist dance coach 2 hrs per week in addition to PE lessons Provision of after school dance club	£3000	All children improve dance skills by receiving specialist teaching. All children to perform a finished piece to school. Staff upskilled by observing and participating in lessons	Staff are present during their class dance lessons so could deliver this in future
Surfing lessons for Y6 children	£2000	All children are water confident and able to stand up on a surf board! A life skill which children will develop as we live by the sea.	Staff are present in lessons and could provide body boarding rather than surfing lessons
Release of teacher to take teams to sporting events 1 afternoon per week Transport to venues	£4000	All children in school able to participate in sporting events and representing school.	Network of volunteers is building up
Contribution to SSCO post at local secondary school	£3000	All children take part in centrally organised sporting events	This money would be needed to be found to sustain the partnership
Fishing - Y6	£1500	All children engage in this sport and understand its part in our coastal heritage	Staff could deliver lessons about fishing - but not the experience!
Beach Schools training for new staff and support for beach activities	£5000	Children become resilient and confident learners and transfer these skills into the classroom Children can use the beach safely and independently by completing 70 things before they leave (these are progressive skills throughout the years)	Staff trained to deliver beach curriculum to their own class. Experienced member of staff to initially support for water for more

			advanced water and fire activities.
Contribution to swimming - beyond 25m	£2000	Our school takes children from Y2-Y6 swimming every week. Our children can all swim 25m very quickly, we continue these lessons to develop technique and stamina due to our coastal location	We would have to reduce swimming lessons
