Caedmon and Eskdale Consultation

We are delighted to see the exciting news from Caedmon and Eskdale School regarding future federation. Closer working links between the schools can only be good news for all the young people in our town □ If you have not read the letter, here are the main points

- The federation will strengthen and improve the resilience of both schools and enable them to provide the best possible quality of secondary education for all students in the Whitby area.
- Under these proposals, there will be one, single governing body, overseeing two legally separate schools.
- It is not a merger and is not the first step towards a merger. Under these proposals the two schools will remain separate, with two headteachers, separate budgets, using existing school buildings.
- There will be a new, shared Sixth Form Centre based on the Scoresby site, with Year 7 & 8 students moving to the Normanby site from September 2019
