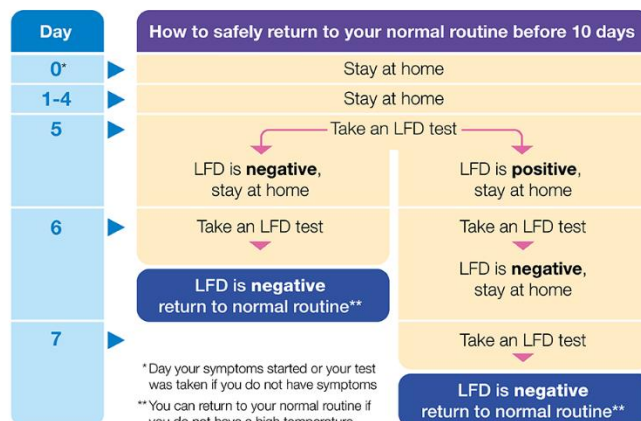

Covid Update

We have a sharp rise in cases in school this week, both staff and children. We would ask that if your child does have symptoms, you still get them tested, and that if they do have a positive result then they isolate from school for at least 5 days (if they then have a negative test). It appears that vomiting now seems to be another common symptom 😞

The current government guidance is as follows: Children and young people with COVID-19 should not attend their education setting while they are infectious. They should take an LFD test from 5 days after their symptoms started (or the day their test was taken if they did not have symptoms) followed by another one the next day. If both these tests results are negative, they should return to their educational setting if they normally attend one, as long as they feel well enough to do so and do not have a temperature. They should follow the guidance for their educational setting.



If your day 5 LFD test result is positive, you can continue taking LFD tests until you receive 2 consecutive negative test results.
